PACKING LIST:

- Instrument, Binder, Pencil, **Good Attitude**
- Band Uniform (bib, jacket, gauntlets, perf gloves, shakos, wraps, plume)
- Anything else you need to play (Extra Reeds, Sticks, Grease, Mallets, etc.)
- Long Black Socks & Band T-Shirt (MUST BE WORN UNDER UNIFORM!!!)
- Light Clothing for **3 days** (St. George is close to Las Vegas, NV and weather is warm!). Bring extra socks.
- Sleeping Bag or Blanket & Pillow
- Toothbrush & Toiletries for 3 days
- Spending \$\$\$ for Event Souvenirs & 3 Meals (Students Responsible for Lunch Costs Each Day)
- Any **school appropriate** movies, games, etc. that you might want to enjoy at the Resort
- Bathing Suit or Swim Trunks & Sunscreen for Beach/Pool/Hottub

IMPORTANT INFO & REMINDERS:

- Students MUST travel to St. George on the bus, with the entire band.
- Students may leave with their parents on Saturday after awards, but they must have a release form on file **PRIOR** to the trip. 18yr old students do not require this. The form is available on www.santafebands.com under the "Documents" Tab.
- The Saturday competition is in 2 stages: Preliminary and Finals. The band will be present at both events, but may only perform in Preliminary contest.
- Tickets for spectators can be purchased for each event (Prelims & Finals) separately, or combined. Tickets can be purchased at the gate, or at www.musicforall.org
- Bands of America enforces a **"clear bag policy"** at their events. Camera bags, purses, and backpacks are **not allowed** in the stadium.
- Students and parents are encouraged to review the "travel policies" section of the Band Handbook (Pg. 12), which can be found at www.santafebands.com under the "documents" tab.
- Please reach out to Mr. Bellon with any questions. Email will be checked frequently during the trip and the remind system will be used for updates throughout.

ATTIRE FOR COMPETITION DAY:

- Students should shower and make sure they're hydrated before getting on the bus.
- Long hair should be pulled in a **tight** bun using a **black** hair-tie.
- Wear long, black socks with no logos or colors whatsoever.
- Wear the blue Band T-shirt under the uniform jacket. In the event of warm weather, **everyone** must be wearing the same T-shirt in order for jackets to be removed.
- No jewelry may be worn whatsoever, with the exception of permanent, non-removable items.
- DO NOT wear anything under the bibbers outside of your normal underwear/undergarments. NO pants, etc.

AT THE EVENT:

- The role of band students and other spectators (parents, families, general community) at the event is **very** different.
- Students are expected to assist in unloading equipment when we return to SFHS.
- We are not only at the contest to perform, we are also there to **watch and support** the other bands.
- The band will sit together, in a block, during the entire event, preliminary awards ceremony, and finals performances. They will travel from site to site as a group and will not roam around the contest. We are "performing" from the moment we exit the bus to the moment we get back on the bus. This is part of our organization's image and is an important part of what we do.
- Non-students are very welcome to sit next to the band, but will be asked not to sit inside the band block (similar to football games).
- In the event of finals performance, the entire band will participate in the awards ceremony on the field, with the other finals bands. The entire band must be present to accept awards and will be expected to be present.
